Cobalt International Energy, Inc. (CIE) has announced a 1-for-15 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each CIE Common Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.066667 (New) Cobalt International Energy, Inc. Common Shares. Fractional CIE shares will be rounded up to the next whole share. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on June 19, 2017.
