## **PRICING**

The underlying price for the ENLK2D Futures contract deliverables, expressed in term of current market value, would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{ENLK2D} = 1.15 (\text{ENLC})$$

Please note that the valuation would apply only to the ENLK2D deliverable in terms of current market value of the deliverable securities. The resulting price would not be equivalent to the daily settlement price of a futures contract month, whose determination would include cost of money carrying charges, adjustment for dividends, and other factors.

## **BACKGROUND**

On January 23, 2019, Shareholders of EnLink Midstream Partners, LP (ENLK) voted concerning the proposed merger with EnLink Midstream, LLC (ENLC). The merger was approved and subsequently consummated on January 25, 2019. As a result, each existing ENLK Common Unit will be converted into the right to receive 1.15 ENLC Common Units.
