ArcelorMittal (MT) has announced a 1-for-3 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each MT American Depositary Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.333333 (New) ArcelorMittal American Depositary Shares. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on May 22, 2017. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional shares.

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The MT component of the MT1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the MT1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional MT Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
