Miami International Securities Exchange LLC ("MIAX" or "Exchange") is filing this Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-MIAX-2013-58 to make the following changes to clarify that the an ERP Member may not have a ERP Director position in addition to a Member Representative Director position.

1. P. 35, in the Exhibit 5, the Exchange proposes to remove the following language:

"Any ERP Member (either by itself or with its affiliates) that is not otherwise represented on the Board in a position other than as a Member Representative Director may have the right to nominate one (1) ERP Director or appoint an Observer to the Board of Directors. If at any time such ERP Member is otherwise able to nominate an ERP Director hereunder but is unable to fill such position as a result of such ERP Member already having a representative on the Board in a position other than as a Member Representative Director, such ERP Member will have the right to nominate such Director in accordance with this Article II, Section 2.2(e) upon the resignation or removal of such Director already serving on the Board. The ERP Member's right to nominate a Director or appoint an Observer pursuant to this Section 2.2(e) shall be perpetual, subject to the provisions of Section 2.3 below. The nominee shall be appointed at the first annual meeting of the Company following the Effective Date."

And replace the language with the following:

"Any ERP Member (either by itself or with its affiliates) that is not otherwise represented on the Board may have the right to nominate one (1) ERP Director or appoint an Observer to the Board of Directors. If at any time such ERP Member is otherwise able to nominate an ERP Director hereunder but is unable to fill such position as a result of such ERP Member already having a representative on the Board, such ERP Member will have the right to nominate such Director in accordance with this Article II, Section 2.2(e) upon the resignation or removal of such Director already serving on the Board. The ERP Member's right to nominate a Director or appoint an Observer pursuant to this Section 2.2(e) shall be perpetual, subject to the provisions of Section 2.3 below. The nominee shall be appointed at the first annual meeting of the Company following the Effective Date."

- 2. P. 35, in the Exhibit 5, the Exchange proposes to remove the following language:
 - "(i) Any ERP Member that is not otherwise represented on the Board in a position other than as Member Representative Director shall have the right to appoint one individual as an Observer. If the ERP Member is otherwise able to nominate an ERP Director, an Observer appointment would be in lieu of such ERP Director nomination."

And replace the language with the following:

- "(i) Any ERP Member that is not otherwise represented on the Board shall have the right to appoint one individual as an Observer. If the ERP Member is otherwise able to nominate an ERP Director, an Observer appointment would be in lieu of such ERP Director nomination."
- 3. P. 6, fn 7 of the Purpose Section in the 19b-4, the Exchange proposes to remove the following language:

"At this time, an ERP Member may only have at most a Member Representative Director and an ERP Director, or a Member Representative Director and an Observer, but not an ERP Director and an Observer."

And replace the language with the following:

"At this time, an ERP Member that is represented by a Member Representative Director may also have an Observer. But, an ERP Member that is represented by an ERP Director may not also have an Observer."

P. 19, to the Purpose Section in <u>Exhibit 1</u>, the Exchange also proposes to make the corresponding changes as necessary.
